

# Connect the Dots

This is a two player game that is great to use with repetitions. Each time the student does a repetition where they meet their goal, a player (either themselves or the practice partner) will take a turn drawing a line between a pair of dots. Be sure that you both agree that the student has achieved their goal before drawing a line. If you do not both agree, simply have the student play it again. Lines can be drawn anywhere but must be horizontal or vertical and between adjacent dots. The goal is to make four sides of a box. Each time you create a box, put your initial in the box and take another turn for free! The player who creates the most boxes wins. The game is over when the board is completely filled with boxes. To get to this point you likely will need to work throughout your practice on filling in the game, or perhaps throughout the week.
