

# Faces to Draw

This is a drawing game. Choose to add a face to sunglasses or to fill in a face in the oval circles. There are lots of natural parts to faces – eyes, eye brows, eye lashes, nose, ears, lips, teeth, tongue, chin, cheeks, hair, facial hair, moles, wrinkles... And there are things we add to our faces, too – hats, jewelry, headphones, glasses... Be creative!

Option 1: Use this game with repetitions by working on one face per group of repetitions. For each repetition you do where you meet your goal, either the parent or student can add a part to the face (silly or serious). If there is disagreement on whether the student reached their goal or not, be sure the goal is clear and attainable (easy!) and then play it again without marking anything down that time.

Option 2: Use this game as a break in your practice or to celebrate a successful practice. See how much you can fit into one face in one minute.
